FOOD:

There will be a free Saturday dinner and breakfast.

Horses: Are permitted.

Artillery: Two cannons are needed per side; The Washington Artillery can bring three if needed.

Parking. You need a parking pass to avoid having to pay the park entry fee. When your unit registers I will send you Unit commander one

Also there is free RV parking in the public parking area, or just pay \$10.00 for a regular site.

Directions: see the web page for a map. Highway 71 (South) exit Euclid. Go left over the fwy. On Euclid Traveling North exit Euclid go right on Euclid. Site is on the right about a mile and a half, go through the arch continue through the park until you see the welcome/registration people.

Camps: The same camp locations as last year. Camps will be judged.
